

WEEE Compliance Statement

Registration Number WEE/DG0045SY

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 (Directive 2012/19/EU) apply to all Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) placed on the market in the UK covered by the scope of the Regulations.

The directive aims to reduce the waste arising from Electrical and Electronic Equipment and improve the environmental performance of everything involved in the life cycle of EEE and to minimise the amount of material entering this waste stream.

In order to comply with the WEEE directive, Solent Scientific Ltd have taken the following actions

- Solent Scientific Ltd carry out in-house monitoring and detailed reporting to enable us to determine how much EEE has entered the UK market.
- All EEE entering the UK market, as well as carrying a unique serial number, is marked with the 'crossed out wheeled bin'.



This symbol indicates that the equipment carrying this mark must not be thrown into general waste but should be collected separately and properly processed for disposal under local regulations.

- Reports are submitted to the relevant authority with information of the tonnage of EEE products placed into the UK market by Solent Scientific Ltd.
- We provide an end-of-life solution for all products sold within the UK by accepting back any end-of-life EEE for processing by a local registered waste disposal company.

The WEEE directive has been transposed into each EU member state's legislation and so the exact details will vary slightly from country to country, but the above principals will apply. In particular, the arrangements for the separate collection of WEEE will vary in each country but might include for example; public collection points. The directive encourages reuse, recycling and other forms of recovery in order to prevent WEEE. Solent Scientific fully support this aim by reusing and recycling where possible.

Users of EEE in the E.U. can also play an important role in reducing WEEE and helping the environment by disposing of WEEE properly.

Solent Scientific Ltd has registered as a producer in the UK, registration number WEE/DG0045SY. However, please be aware that Solent Scientific Ltd producer registration will only provide compliance for EEE products purchased from us and entered directly into the UK Market. Any person who is responsible for importing any Solent Scientific Ltd products into any E.U. member state or other country should ensure that they comply with any WEEE or other laws applicable in their country.
